The insurance industry is a significant contributor to Florida's economy and provides more than **200,000 jobs** in Florida, bringing **\$13.4 billion** in annual wages into the economy.

Florida insurance industry generated approximately **\$21.2 billion** in total economic output—**2.8%** of Florida's gross state product.<sup>2</sup>

AND the total (property casualty, life and health) insurance industry **PAYS \$711 million** in premium taxes to the state each year, among a wide range of other state and local taxes<sup>3</sup>


